

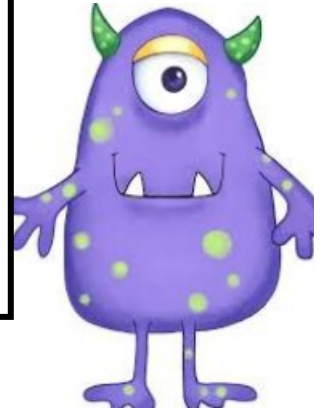

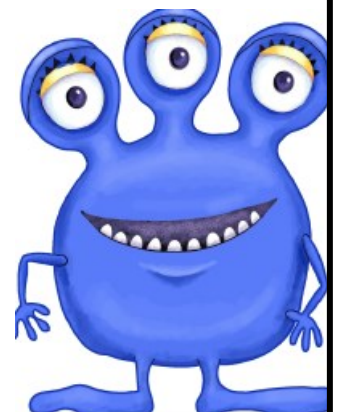
Draw a picture of what you think heaven will be like. It is a reminder that in Jesus we have a living hope, a future that is guaranteed and can never be destroyed or spoilt.
